Glossary

1:1 Case Work – Any activity relating to work completed one to one with a service user where they are held on a caseload, including signposting, referrals, wrap around support, family liason and support etc.

Community Engagement – Community events and activities, detached youth work and rapid response to ASB incidents, holiday activities, outreach work etc.

Employability Support – work placement tasters and activities, supporting people to access training providers and employers, workplace buddy support, CV, interview and job search support

Enrichment Activities – DOE expedition, skill development and challenges, residential trips, enrichment activities and group events

Group-work Programmes – activities where groups of young people come together to discuss or explore issues, including targeted group-work, traded services, peer education, Xtra push and DKHT Get on Track, bespoke groupwork and training etc.

Informal Education – any activities that provide opportunity for learning and development in an informal setting, e.g. open access youth work and youth clubs, (including SEND youth clubs), positive and productive activities, educational or skills based trips and events

Information, Advice and Guidance – Information giving, careers Advice, Guidance, and action planning, support with CV writing and mock interviews, and job search, wider information advice and guidance given to su's

Mentoring Support – one to one support to service users that are not case loaded, advocacy, signposting and making referrals, bridged tranistions to other sources of support etc.

Participation and Involvement –Young Advisors, Youth Cabinet and Youth Parliament, consultation work, youth proofing, involving young people in service design, delivery and evaluation, commissioning of services support, recruitment and selection, campaigns & events etc.

Peer to Peer Support – activities that enable and facilitate service users supporting each other "peer to peer", including training and supporting junior leaders, peer led groupwork etc.

Resource Development – Printed, electronic or virtual resources that support service users or provide IAG, e.g. Things to Do Guide, Options Guide, Website and social media content

Volunteering – supporting young people into volunteering opportunities, social action projects, service users supporting community engagement events or activities, etc.
